The oil pressure adjustment valve is a simple device but critical to safe flight operations. After adjustment, a few short local flights are required to verify that OP remains in the correct range during all phases of flight. We sometimes use these short flights to build goodwill among the airport staff & police. They enjoy the thrill of flight, and it allows us the opportunity to evangelize and check on the spiritual wellbeing of those we work closely with.
